1. * (i) A copy of partnership deed in case of a partnership firm,
(ii) Memorandum & Articles of Association in case of a Private /Public Ltd. Companies along with a copy of certificate of incorporation of the company & the name of the promoters,
(iii) In case of Limited Liability Partnership (LLP), a copy of agreement along with certificate of incorporation and
(iv) In case of One Person Company (OPC), a copy of certificate of incorporation, Memorandum & Article of Association, name of person to whom company devolve after death or incapacity of the person who makes that company.
2. * Copy of Registration of Society/Trust along with Deed
3. * Copy of resolution of Board of Company/Trust for authoring a person to file the application along with his identity proof
4. * Project Report/Project Profile
5. NOC from Pollution Control Board and Details of Effluents
6. Copy of Acknowledgement of Entrepreneurial Memorandum - Part-I (For MSME)
7. * Certificate required for concessional category allotment
 - a. **Electronic Unit**- Certificate issued by the Director of Industries as Electronic Industry
 - b. **Member of SC/ST**- Caste Certificate issued by competent Revenue Authorities.
 - c. **Ex-Service Man**- Certificate of Sainik Board
 - d. **War Widow** – Certificate of Sainik Board certifying that her husband was employee of Indian Army/Navy/Air Force and died in war/action.
 - e. **Disabled Persons** – Certificate issued by A Medical Authority Certifying that person is suffering from not less than forty percent of any disability
 - f. **Solar Energy Unit** – Certificate issued by Director of Industries that the project is related to Solar Energy
